Petroleum Products Subsidy Repayment Form

NOTE:

- This form is to be completed when:
 - ▶ more than **100 litres** of subsidised diesel is purchased in one transaction (multiple purchases on any one day are defined as one transaction) **and**
 - ▶ it is **not** delivered into a running tank of a road vehicle **and**
 - ▶ it is consumed for off-road purposes
- OR
 - ▶ subsidised petroleum products are sold and delivered to the premises of a consumer for use in connection with a business or activity within a particular zone **and**
 - ▶ petroleum product is consumed or resold outside of that zone
- Refer to the map and examples of how to calculate your repayment amount on page 2
- Complete this form within 60 days of purchase and return with your cheque or money order to Office of State Revenue, GPO Box 4042, Sydney NSW 2001
- Print clearly in the boxed spaces

Petroleum Products Subsidy Repayment

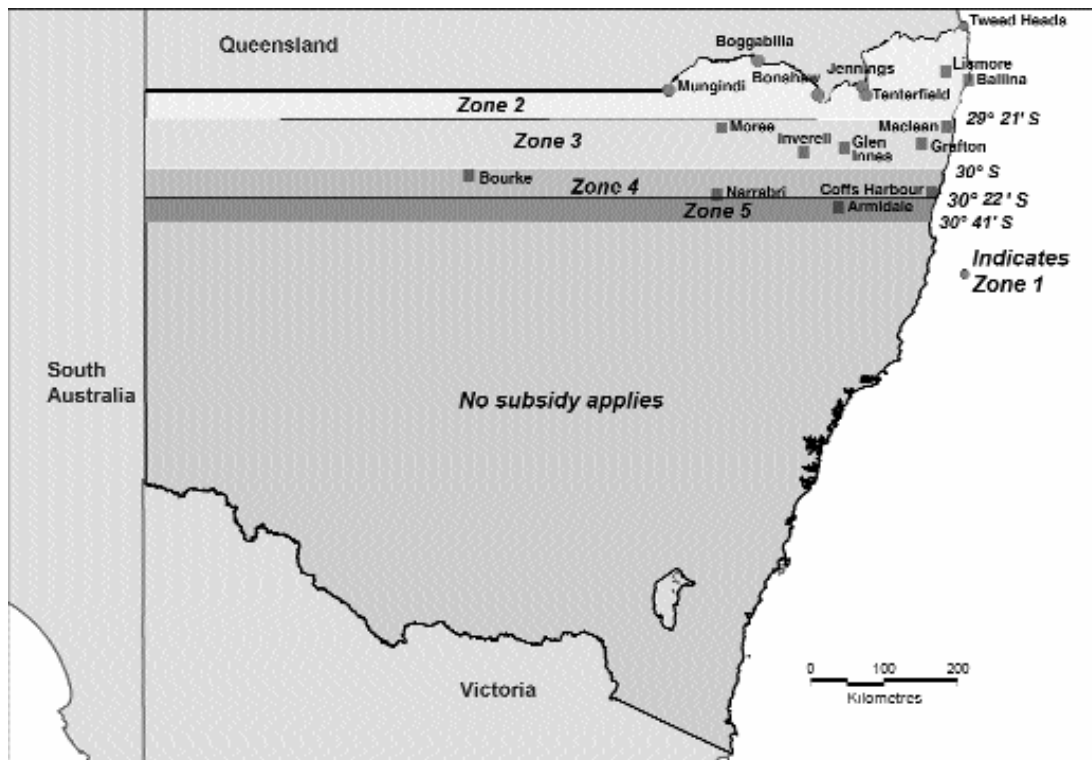
Examples of how to calculate repayment amount

The invoice provided by the vendor will display the volume of fuel purchased and the rate of subsidy applicable to that fuel.

Example	Subsidy rate per litre	Amount to repay
If all the fuel has been consumed for off-road purpose, the amount to repay is the volume used multiplied by the rate of subsidy, eg: 200 litres of diesel is purchased in zone 2 and is used in zone 2 for power generation.	6.68 cents (zone 2)	200 x .0668 = \$13.36
If some of the fuel has been used for off-road purposes, the amount to repay is calculated based on an estimate of the volume used, eg: 1000 litres of diesel is purchased in zone 2 and 300 litres is used in zone 2 for tractor use.	6.68 cents (zone 2)	300 x .0668 = \$20.04
If fuel has been purchased with a subsidy level greater than the level in which the fuel is used for on-road purpose, the difference is to be repaid, eg: 50 000 litres of fuel is purchased in zone 2 and is used in zone 5 for propulsion of buses.	6.68 cents (zone 2) 1.67 cents (zone 5) The difference between the subsidy levels is 5.01 cents	50 000 x .0501 = \$2505.00

Zone	Area	Subsidy rate per litre
1	The towns of Bonshaw, Jennings, Tenterfield, Boggabilla and Mungindi and the area bounded by the border between NSW and Queensland, the Tweed River, Terranora Inlet and the Cobaki Broadwater.	8.35 cents
2	The area within NSW between latitude 29 degrees and 21 minutes south and the Queensland border and west to the NSW border excluding the area in Zone 1.	6.68 cents
3	The area within NSW between latitude 29 degrees 21 minutes south and latitude 30 degrees south and west to the NSW border.	5.01 cents
4	The area within NSW between latitude 30 degrees south, latitude 30 degrees 22 minutes south and west to the NSW border.	3.34 cents
5	The area within NSW bounded by latitude 30 degrees 22 minutes, latitude 30 degrees 41 minutes south and west to the NSW border.	1.67 cents
