INFRINGEMENT PROCESSING BUREAU

NSW Treasurer Michael Egan announced today that the Infringement Processing Bureau at Maitland would be transferred to the Office of State Revenue on 1 October 2003.

The Bureau, which is currently part of NSW Police, will remain in Maitland.

The head office of the Office of State Revenue is located at Parramatta.

Mr Egan said that the transfer of the IPB would allow the Police Commissioner and his executives to better focus their time and expertise on their core tasks of investigating and preventing crime.

The IPB should also benefit by being placed with an agency which has a reputation for quality client service and efficient revenue collection practices.

“The transfer follows the move of the State Debt Recovery Office to the Office of State revenue in April last year,” Mr Egan said.

“The transfer of the IPB to OSR should provide a more streamlined service for the collection of fines.”
